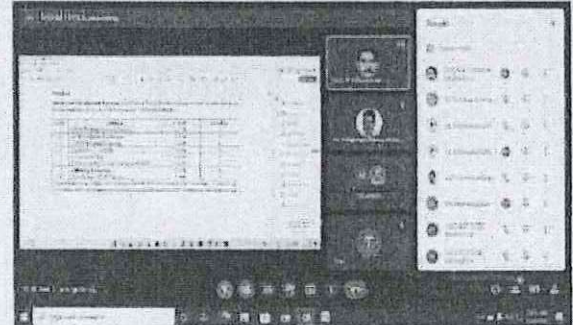
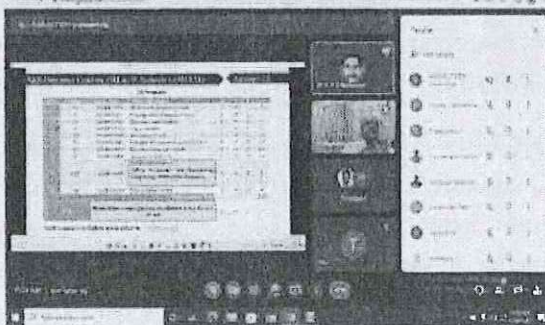
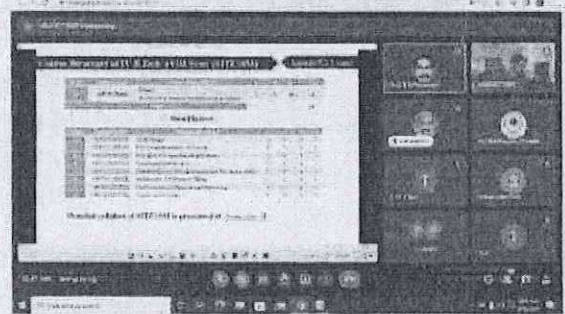
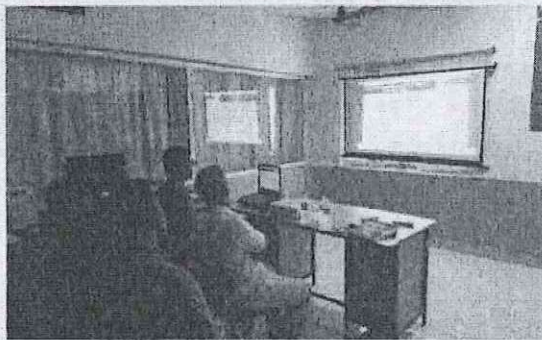


Figure 1: Snapshots of the 5th BoS meeting, Electronics and Communication Engineering department.

	Resolution	<p>After reviewing, the BoS members approved the course structure and syllabus with the following suggestions.</p> <p>The members suggested verifying the possibility of swapping the Engineering Economics & Financial Management subject in the 7th semester with other professional core subjects in the lower semesters. After re-examining the course structure, we came to the conclusion that there is no possibility for the replacement due to the following reasons.</p> <p>The only possibility is swapping the Engineering Economics & Financial Management course in the 7th semester with a core subject in the 6th semester as the Management Science course is considered in the 5th semester. However, this possibility led to an imbalance in the department's teaching workload between odd and even semesters as there were no theory subjects in the 8th semester (only project).</p>




