The members of the BoS are to attend the meeting through online mode in ZOOM (External members) and offline mode (internal members)

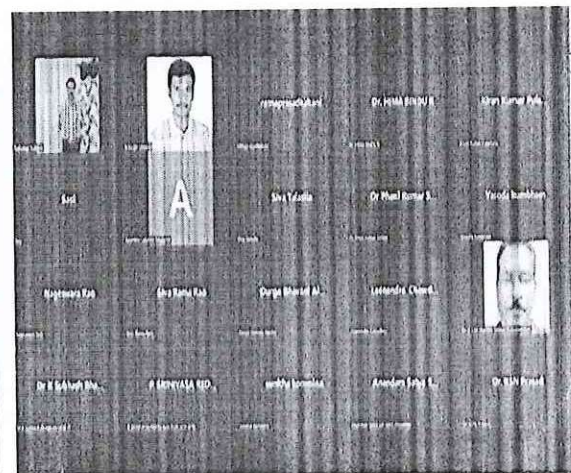
