Agenda – III: To review Management Science related subjects to undergraduate program i.e., B.Tech

Resolution – III

The members of the BoS discussed about the necessary modifications in the Management Science related subjects for B.Tech programs. The subjects in the present curriculum are Engineering Economics and Financial Analysis (EEFA), Management Science (MS) and Constitution of India, Professional Ethics and Human Rights (PEHR). The members wanted to continue with the same titles and syllabus in the SITI, 21 regulations. The recommendation was to include Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 in the subject titled Constitution of India, Professional Ethics and Human Rights.
