Minutes of Meeting:

The chairman Sri B. Venu Gopala Krishna chaired the meeting and with the permission of the chair, Member Secretary invited the members to the 8th Governing Body meeting on 09/11/2019 @ Board Room.

Resolutions:-

- 1] Member secretary has reviewed about the 8th Governing body meeting resolutions and explained the action taken.
- 2] Member secretary submitted the detailed report about the JNTUK dues and its necessary to clear. All the members asked the authorities to clear dues immediately after govt. credits the tuition fee.
- 3] Members reviewed about the admissions taken place for the A/Y 2018-20. Asked Member Secretary to take necessary steps to improve the admissions at UG, PG & Diploma level.
- 4] Member secretary addressed the members about the readmission policy under JNTUK & Autonomous system. Members agreed & asked to follow the system accordingly.
- 5] Members reviewed the income & expenditure for the F/Y 2018-19 and approved.
- 6] Member secretary has presented the budget requirement for the A/Y 2019-20 and suggested to optimize the expenditure.

7] Member secretary narrated the procedure of appointing various positions (like identifying vacancies at various levels, advertisements then sending to selection committee for sorting & decisions). All members accepted & approved the list of faculty selected for various positions.

8] Based on technology change, member secretary addressed the need of value added programs. Members agreed to continue with the same and asked to invite various professionals and trainees to fulfill the need.

9] All the members reviewed the present scenario. Members finally decided and asked member secretary to focus on the following programs for the AY 2020-21 AICTE approval process.

- (i) computer science & Technology - like CSE
 - (ii) Artificial intelligence & Data Science
 - (iii) Electronics & communication Technology - like ECE
- And withdraw one division from Mechanical Engg. in view of poor demand.

10] All members reviewed the academic performance of the students and expressed satisfactory. Members asked member secretary to focus on the below average students by motivating in various means.

11] Member secretary addressed the members about the expenditure expected to incur due to various programs / electives paper setting, valuation and rise in honorarium to the examiners. Member thoroughly discussed the situation and agreed to increase the exam

fee by Rs. 500/- per candidate per exam (i.e. Rs. 2000/- for whole exam.)

12] Member secretary briefed about the situation related to paper setting, valuation work at UG / PG & other payments at the time of examination conducted. Members reviewed and accepted the proposal & change, and asked to implement the same from March-2020 exam onwards.

13] Member secretary addressed the members about short fall of the built up area for various events, programs. All the members reviewed the situation and accepted to add separate built up area for Computer Science, for around 6000 Sqm and Administrative block including Exam Section around 6000 Sqm based on the financial position.

14] In view of frequent visits by various guests, visitors and professionals to the institute, there is a need for providing fullpledged Guest house, and the same has been briefed by member secretary. Members reviewed and accepted to arrange the built up area at the earliest.

15] Member secretary briefed about the need of submitting application to NBA for accreditation of U.Tech (HE & IT). Members accepted to submit accordingly.
